The awards, which are run by The Southern Star in conjunction with the Celtic Ross Hotel, were set up to honour people in West Cork who go above and beyond the call of duty to help and improve the lives of others. They celebrate amazing individuals who are doing extraordinary things in their West Cork communities. Sharon was presented her award for her selfless work as a carer.

The overall West Cork Hero award winner for 2017 will be selected from the 12 monthly winners chosen during the past year and will be announced at a gala invitation-only luncheon in the Celtic Ross Hotel on Friday, February 23rd.

MIZEN COMMUNITY ALERT can help elderly and vulnerable people gain access to a low cost Medical Alert System and free 10 year Smoke Alarms.

Smoke Alarms – An average of 50 people die in fires each year and the vast majority of these fatalities occur in the home. Most fatal fires occur while people are sleeping. Smoke produced in a fire does not wake people but rather puts them into a deeper sleep. A smoke alarm will react early to smoke and will give you the precious minutes necessary to get out safely

Medical Alerts – Regardless of age, whether you live on your own or with others there is always a chance that you may need help. A medical alert system provides you with the reassurance that help is available 24 hours a day so that you can continue to live safely and independently at home.

The alarm unit and pendant (which can be worn around the neck or on the wrist) is linked to a monitoring centre. By pressing the pendant an emergency call is made to an advisor who will arrange for a relative, friend, neighbour to call on you immediately or can also contact the emergency services on your behalf. The setting up costs are approx. 56 euro and approx. 10 euro per month thereafter.

A more elaborate device is available for people who are active outside the home. This device can be carried in a bag or pocket when out walking or working in the garden. Initial cost of this device is 111 euro and the monthly cost is approx. 30 euro per month.
