WORLD OF MUSIC AND LOCAL COMMUNITY MOURNS PASSING OF A MUSIC STAR

The local Community was plunged in to great sadness today with the passing of Colin Vearncombe following a recent road accident. Colin, who has lived in Schull for many years with his family, was well known locally. Since news of his accident the whole Community silently prayed and wished for good news, but as the days went by the news people wished for was not happening and this news of his passing has numbed this united Community. Colin Vearncombe had a taste of pop stardom nearly three decades ago, but his music is just as intriguing today. He had a 35-year career in music, releasing his first single with Black, 'Human Features'. In 1981. Black signed a major label deal with WEA in 1984, but was dropped. In 1985, he wrote and released the single 'Wonderful Life', as a comment on his situation, which became a worldwide hit after it was rereleased by A&M in 1987. 'Sweetest Smile' was released in the same year. Colin, a Liverpoolian, continued working, releasing eight albums as Black and six under his own name, including last year's Black album, Blind Faith, which received a four-star review in the Guardian. Black's management said today they were aware many people will want to celebrate his life and work. They added: "No need to laugh or cry. It's a wonderful, wonderful life."

To this Community it was also a wonderful life and the Community mourns with his family at this time. Sincere sympathy is extended to his family and friends.

The scheme which has been in operation in West Cork since 2008 is for the installation of attic and cavity wall insulation, the service is **free of charge** for all eligible households. To be eligible for the scheme, you must own your own home, it must be built before 2006, and you must be in receipt of one of the following;

- * The Winter fuel allowance, or
- * Family Income Supplement, or
- * Job Seeker's Allowance for over six months and with a child under 7 years of age.
