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CYCLE AGAINST SUICIDE COMES TO MIZEN. Join in spreading the message "It's OK not to feel OK; and it's absolutely OK to ask for help". We are delighted to be involved yet again in the Mizen with the cycle against suicide and we would urge all to help with this year's event.

On Sunday, July 24th, the community of Goleen will host a 50 km cycle as part of the Cycle Against Suicide SpinOff series. A SpinOff is a locally organised spin that takes place once each month after the main Cycle ends. The events are locally organised, owned by the community and championed by Cycle Against Suicide 'local leaders.' A SpinOff has all the colour, energy and fun of the annual Cycle but is packed into a single day. Entertainment, refreshments and, of course, a mental well-being event takes place before and after the cycle.


The leading charity's core aim is to challenge stigma, foster a mind-set where it becomes absolutely the norm to acknowledge not feeling OK, encourage help seeking behaviour, and guide those in need to where that help exists. According to Jim Breen, Cycle Against Suicide founder, "Every individual, every family, every community has some connection with suicide, self-harm or depression. Our mental health is just like our physical health - it is something we have to nurture and be mindful of - from time to time we have to ask for help - and that is OK. As a Movement, we believe that the best way to help fight the battle against suicide in Ireland, is to do it together, through mobilising communities. The SpinOff series is a key component in changing mind-set and behaviour."

The SpinOff will depart from Goleen Community Centre at 11am on Sunday, July 24th. The route snakes along the picturesque coastal landscape of West Cork, overlooking Dunmanus Bay, before breaking for lunch in Schull. This 50km route is the perfect opportunity to help spread the Cycle Against Suicide message, "It's OK not to feel OK; and it's absolutely OK to ask for help", while simultaneously participating in an incredibly uplifting and positive event. You don't have to be an avid cyclist to take part as a leisurely pace is maintained throughout. If you would prefer to volunteer rather than cycle, then the Goleen SpinOff Committee are looking for supporters and volunteers in advance of the event as well as on the day itself.

There are many ways to become involved if you would like to play your part in breaking the cycle of suicide on the island of Ireland. From cycling to volunteering, or even simply supporting, all are welcome in Goleen on July 24th. We are looking for your help in a few ways; would you be able to take in a few people for the night, who are doing the cycle? We also need volunteers for stewarding for a short while, in various areas along the way on Sunday 24th.
